# PALM SUNDAY

## The Events of Palm Sunday...

### **1. SHOWED GOD'S \_\_\_\_\_.**

*So they went and found the colt, just as Jesus had said. And sure enough, as they were untying it, the owners asked them, "Why are you untying that colt?"* Luke 19:32-35 NLT

*For your Father knows exactly what you need even before you ask him!* Matthew 6:8b NLT

*And you must commit yourselves wholeheartedly to these commands that I am giving you today. Repeat them again and again to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are on the road, when you are going to bed and when you are getting up.* Deuteronomy 6:6-7 NLT

### **2. ALLOWED FOR \_\_\_\_\_.**

*After that, he taught daily in the Temple, but the leading priests, the teachers of religious law, and the other leaders of the people began planning how to kill him. But they could think of nothing, because all the people hung on every word he said.* Luke 19:47-48 NLT

Remember what I told you: I am going away, but I will come back to you again. If you really loved me, you would be happy that I am going to the Father, who is greater than I am.
